At the end of the seventies and beginning of the eighties one could notice a development from the functional towards the sculptural in ceramics and this, together with my interest in three dimensional work, made me specialise on the sculptural aspects of the visual arts and more specifically in ceramics.

Why would one specialise in a material? That is not what art is about. My special interest went more and more towards the monumental, the spatial and architectual aspects, and also to elements of landscape. Thus very much about the material and the earth.

While the basic element of the gallery is clay, I will show ceramic works incorporating elements of bronze, wood, paper or any other material, as well as two dimensional drawings.

The gallery works with a fixed group of artists, and follows the development and growth of each artist with keen interest. Now and then new artists that are crossing material boundaries are invited to exhibit and become part of the artist group.
